WHITE WINES

11 Chardonnay Les Argelières, Pays d'Oc, France

Rich and generous Chardonnay from the South of France. Balanced with bright tropical fruit and integrated oak influences.

12 Viognier Mont Rocher, Pays d'Oc, France

Peachy, dry and mouth-wateringly fresh Viognier.

13 Verdejo Silga Rueda, Spain

Verdejo has characteristics similar to Sauvignon Blanc, but with intense passionfruit and a savoury mineral twist. Cracking summer / seafood white.

14 Picpoul de Pinet Beauvignac, Languedoc, France

This dry, citrus and mineral white from the shores of the Med is a perfect foil for simple seafood dishes.

15 Côtes de Roussillon Blanc Bila Haut, France

Dry and complex white food wine. Grenache Blanc lends a spice and savoury mineral character.

16 Sauvignon Blanc 'The Mayfly', Marlborough, New Zealand

You will be hooked by this classic Marlborough Sauvignon. The fruit is sourced by (and the wine made by) renowned local winemaker, Ben Riggs.

Dry, characterful and interesting version of this fascinating Hungarian grape. Tokaj's volcanic soils add minerality and Furmint naturally has a good weight of pear and tropical fruit. A lovely alternative to Chardonnay or Viognier.

18 A Mano Bianco, Puglia, Italy

Stunningly blend of Southern Italian grape varieties. The Fiano grape lends aromatic qualities whilst Greco and Falanghina provide the acidity and mineral components. Perfect with crab or spiced dishes.

This beautifully poised wine has the classic richness and hallmark rose petal and lychee of good Gewurz, but then it is taut and relatively dry and clean on the finish.

Classic and elegant Sancerre from a respected producer in Bué in the heart of the Appellation.

27 Meursault Les Tillets Domaine Jean Javiller, Bourgogne, France 2014 (organic)

Classic and generous white Burgundy from this famous village, (and organic into the bargain!)

Classic claret with Merlot to the fore. An impressive organic estate.

Plump, rich and velvety with spicy characters typical of Zinfandel. Cool climate coastal fruit and traditional winemaking.

Soft, fragrant and mouth-watering Gamay. Fleurie is the most elegant of the Beaujolais 'Cru' villages.

A wild beast indeed! 70 year old Alicanté vines. Dark black fruits, pepper and herbs and a label you have to see to believe... (why not order it!) Think Rhône meets Chilean Cabernet on steroids!

49 Pinot Noir 'Collectables' Walnut Block, Marlborough New Zealand

Seriously impressive Pinot Noir with a great depth of fruit and lovely fruit 'compôte' flavours.

Rich, powerful and voluptuous with concentrated flavours. Grenache and 20% Syrah using biodynamic viticultural practices.

51 Heirloom Vineyards Shiraz, Barossa Valley, Australia 2014

Grown up Barossa Shiraz (with low sulphur), this is of course a big wine, but it has a freshness and purity missing in more traditional Barossa reds.

A very good example of this famous Rhône red. Dark, brooding and powerful.

DESSERT WINES

65 Château Fayau Cadillac Bordeaux 2011

A rich and unctuous sweet wine just along the river from Sauternes. Honey and apricots and a long finish.

66 Côteaux du Layon Domaine Baumard, Loire, France 2014

Late harvested Chenin Blanc with a bit of noble rot, this is sweet yet fresh with the Chenin Blanc citrus core. Mouth-wateringly delicious.

67 Viognier Late Harvest Valle Secreto, Cachapoal, Chile 2015

The opulence of Viognier, magnified by late harvesting and noble rot. Powerful, intense and over-flowing with peach and apricot.

Dark, nutty, sweet and intense. Grenache Noir, Grenache Gris and Carignan, matured in a solera system started with wines in 1928, and then bottled from a single cask (this is number 933). You have to try this!
