1 Table Peak Chenin Blanc, South Africa

South Africa's most popular grape variety. Youthful, fruity character and a fresh zesty acidity. Very well balanced.

2 Cape 312 Sauvignon Blanc, South Africa

This Sauvignon Blanc is pale lemon in colour, persistent and refreshing on the palate with a very fine fruit bouquet. Fruity and refreshing with floral, citrus and green apple flavours balanced by a hint of ripe tropical fruit.

3 Sentina Pinot Grigio Umbria, Italy

8 Pelusas Merlot, Chile

56 Di Maria Prosecco, Italy

Pale light yellow in colour with fine perlage. Delicately fruity, slightly aromatic bouquet. Well balanced and light body. Excellent as an aperitif and also wonderful with fish and shellfish.

58 Danebury "Cossack" Hampshire Sparkling Wine

WHITE WINES

11 Vistana Chardonnay , Chile

A ripe full bodied wine with concentrated plum and strawberry fruit flavours, cinnamon notes with soft tannins on the long finish.

12 Centum Verdejo Rueda, Spain

Pale straw yellow with distinctive green hues, the wine has an extremely aromatic grassy aroma and is full bodied, dry, herbaceous and extremely refreshing. Its finish is fruity, long and silky.

13 Vermentino La Guadi del Mori, Italy

Pale yellow in colour with green highlights. The bouquet is fresh and inviting, on the palate there are citrus fruits and Mediterranean herbs. Good acidity, full body and pleasant minerality characterize the taste.

14 Riesling Dr Zen Zen, Germany

Delicious on its own as an aperitif, but also an excellent match with seafood dishes that have some spice, squid or sweet and sour dishes, soft shell crabs and all manner of sushi.

15 Canterperdrix Viognier, France

Bright, clear, pale gold colour with green hints. The nose is complex and delicate with notes of quince, honey, butter and fresh white fruit. Canterperdrix le Viognier pairs well with appetizers, shellfish, crustaceans and fish.

16 Marlborough Ridge Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand

Aromas of pawpaw, fresh citrus and lime juice with a distinctive herbal note combine with tropical fruit and classic nettle and gooseberry finish.

17 Albarino Pedra Du Auga, Spain

On the nose, it has an intense aroma, assembling the fruit and floral notes perfectly: highlighting the apple, apricot and peach. In the mouth the emphases is on the freshness typical of the Albariño grape, releasing crisp sensations with a fresh and clean finish.

18 La Girouette Reserve Picpoul de Pinet, France

Vibrant yellow with flecks of green, aromas of lime and citrus fruits, apricot and pear. Refreshing acidity and a creamy texture.

19 Giesen Estate Pinot Gris, New Zealand

Initially aromas of candied pear and quince, followed by a subtle floral lift with lavender.

20 Madeleine Angevine 2014/15 Danebury Hampshire, England

The nose has a fragrant mix of fruits, the palate nectarines and peach with hints of tropical fruits. Apple and pink grapefruit add an attractive balance of flavours and although rich and ripe at the back the finish is apple fresh with just a hint of mineral.

21 Angove "Organic" Chardonnay, Australia

Peach, lemon and cantaloupe melon flavours combine perfectly with delicate oak.

22 Macon Blanc Villages, Domaine De La Grange- Louis Jadot, France

Some of the Chardonnay vines on this 25-hectare domain, lying near the villages of Viré and Lugny, are over 40 years old; their mature state contributes towards producing a wine with a fine, buttery concentration.

23 Gavi Di Gavi- Conte Speroni, Italy

Light straw in colour with delicious aromas of almond trees in blossom. The flavour is dry and harmonious with a slightly bittersweet sensation on the palate.

24 Sancerre Les Colinettes, France 2015

Fermented at low temperature and aged on its lees up until bottling to keep it fresh; this wine is stylish and racy, with the classic blackcurrant leaf and gooseberry character and mineral finish.

25 Chablis Domaine Louis Moreau, France 2016

This fruity and vivid wine presents a nice golden colour and a floral nose with notes of apple and pear typical of Chablis terroir. Chablis wine shows a nice gustatory attack with mineral and chalky hints and a perfect balance in mouth.

26 Pouilly Fuisse Veiles Vignes Domaine Vessigaud, France 2014

As this wine is a blend of different micro climates from Fuissé it has a full body and a complex structure. Well balanced, powerful and rich but full of freshness.

27 Mersault Louis Jadot, France 2015

Meursault wines are traditionally the most charming and approachable of the Côte de Beaune white wines. Louis Jadot vinifies their wine in oak barrels to produce a rich, rounded wine with a delightful toasty-vanilla finish.

28 Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru Vergers Domaine Jean-Marc Pillot 2009

Complex and mature white Burgundy from a Domaine with a growing reputation. Vergers is typically mineral, but has a little more flesh in the ripe 2009 vintage.

4 Sentina Pinot Blush, Italy

This wine has a delicious aroma of strawberries and red berries. With its clean, crisp fruitiness and lasting finish, this is an elegant, well balanced rosé.

35 Ingeno "Organic" Nero D'Avola, Italy

Organic Nero d'Avola with concentrated forest fruits and spiced plums.

36 Canterperdrix Ventoux, France

Clear and bright garnet colour with purple hints. Expressive nose with fruity and spicy aromas. Lively and unctuous in the mouth, well-structured with notes of red and dried fruits.

37 Santa Carolina Reserva Pinot Noir, Chile

Elegant, complex and smooth, this medium bodied wine has strawberry and redcurrant fruit flavours and a soft, lingering finish.

38 Cotes Du Rhone Villages Valreas Domaine Les Meulieres, France

Jammy plum and baked fruits on the nose. Dry and fruit-forward with soft tannins and warming body.

39 Hopes End Grenache - Shiraz- Malbec, Australia

Soft lush boysenberry marmalade and cherry jam laced with subtle new oak with rich, bold flavours.

40 Pilke Estate Grown Malbec, Argentina

This Malbec has an intense deep red/purple colour. Fruity notes of plum, raspberry, dry fig and raisins along with floral notes of violets. Complex and harmonious wine, with a soft and velvety entry, firm tannins and lovely juicy finish.

41 Aristocratico Appassimento del Salento, Italy

Deep ruby-purple with an expressive nose of ripe plums and raisins from grapes that are part dried before fermentation.

42 Whiz Bang Shiraz Barossa, Australia

Ripe raspberries and plum aromas are dominant on the nose with a hint of star anise and white pepper.

43 Paternina Banda Roja, Rioja Reserva, Spain

A Reserva with deep fruit character, great elegance and complexity, aged for 24 months in oak barrels.

44 Lussac St Emilion Chateau Haut Bellevue, France

The wine is a beautiful deep, cherry red hue. This wine reveals an elegant and structured nose which gives way to complex aromas of small black fruits on the palate. A perfect match for roasted red meat, sauce based dishes and cheese

45 Chianti Classico Rocca delle Macie, Italy

This classico wine is aged in Slavonian or French oak barrels for a period of 6 to 10 months. Vibrant ruby red colour with a fruity nose producing hints of light spiciness released by the wood of the barrels. On the palate this wine is savoury and full bodied, with a good aromatic persistency and good structure.

46 Fluerie Chateau Gaillard, France

Full of raspberry, strawberry and black cherry mixed with a twist of black pepper with silky smooth tannins. Well-structured yet light and easy to drink.

47 The Federalist 1776 Zinfandel, Lodi, USA

Lodi is situated inland about 50 miles east of Napa, it is characterised by cool, wet winters, and very warm, dry summers. The wine is aged for 12 months in oak, 25% new. Aromas of plum and cherry are dominant on the nose backed up by cinnamon spice; full-bodied, it has a firm tannin structure developing into a long smooth finish.

48 Giesen Estate 30 Staves Barrel Aged Pinot Noir, New Zealand

Aromas of lifted red berry with tangy red fruit, plum and sweet spices on the palate, with a firm structure.

49 Chateau Pontet Barrial AOC Medoc, France 2012

A round and distinctive palate complemented by complex tannins and aromas of black fruit.

50 Sacco Barolo DOCG, Piedmont, Italy 2013

The colour is ruby red with garnet, brick red nuances. The bouquet is intense, elegant and very complex with notes of mature red fruit, tobacco and the ethereal "Tar and Roses" of classic mature Barolo. The wine is at the lighter end of the Barolo spectrum and fully mature, so expect a more gamey style

51 Chateauneuf Du Pape , Les Bartavelles , Jean Luc Colombo, France 2015

Matured in part in large oak barrels for 16 months. 'Quite fruit-driven, with a big ball of cassis and red liquorice waiting to expand, while notes of Linzer torte, fruit cake and plum pudding fill out the broad, polished finish.' 90 pts (2009) Wine Spectator.

52 Beaune 1er Cru Clos du Rol, France 2015

Our Beaune Premier Cru "Clos du Roi" 2015 has a deep colour with garnet reflections. The nose expresses aromas of cherry and liquorice with a touch of wood. The mouth is full and fresh with crunchy notes of Morello cherries. Tannins are smooth. A balanced wine, with a good persistence.

53 Côte Rotie, Domaine de Bonserine 2010

This tiny Domaine produces wines of the very highest quality and 2010 was an exceptional year for the northern Rhône. 100% Syrah, maturing elegantly. Fragrant and fresh with impressive structure.

54 Château Potensac Cru Bourgeois Médoc, Bordeaux 1995

This Château has been on an upward curve since the Delon family (of Léoville las Cases) took control in the 1970s. Classic Médoc and fully mature, from a fantastic vintage.

This delicious sweet wine has abundant aromas of apricot, honey and rooibos, which carry through to a sumptuous palate.
